3. All entries larger than 16"x20" must be framed in Plexiglas.
4. Only original work having been completed within the last two years and not previously exhibited at this show is eligible for competition in ADULT ADVANCED ART.
5. Novice art exhibits must have been completed within the past year.
6. Each exhibitor is permitted to enter one item per Lot.
7. All paintings must be done by residents of Jackson County and exhibited by the person who did the painting.
8. Paintings previously entered are not eligible.
9. Exhibitor's name and address must be on the back of the painting.
10. PICTURE MUST BE FRAMED AND EQUIPPED WITH HANGING WIRE. NO EXCEPTIONS.
11. **NO ARTWORK WILL BE ACCEPTED IF THE HANGERS AND WIRES ARE NOT STRONG ENOUGH TO HOLD THE ENTRY IN PLACE FOR THE ENTIRE WEEK OF THE SHOW.**
